AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 34 OF THE VILLAGE OF PALESTINE CODE AMENDING 34.17: EXTENDING HOURS FOR LIQUOR SALES WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF PALESTINE, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Palestine, Illinois, has the power to regulate the Code pertaining to the Classes and Fees for the Liquor establishments, pursuant to Illinois Compiled Statutes, Chapter 235, Article I, as amended from time to time.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustee of Palestine, Illinois, has determined certain regulations regarding the Palestine Village Code are necessary and proper for the welfare of the Village and its inhabitants.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Palestine, Crawford County, Illinois, that 34.17 of Chapter 34 of the Palestine Village Code, be, and it is herby amended to be as follows:

34.17: Liquor Licensees operating hours shall be Monday thru Saturday, 10:00 a.m. until 1:00 a.m. and Sunday hours shall be 12:00 noon until 6:00 p.m., only, for the following Classification of Liquor Licenses: Class A, Class A-1, Class A, B, C, Class D, (Class A is Brew Pub).

Class C-1 Liquor License, currently held by Casey's General Store, which has been approved to be open 24 hours per day 7 days per week with operating hours for Beer, Wine and Malt Beverage sales from 6:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. on Monday through Saturday and from 12:00 noon until 6:00 p.m. on Sunday. During such time that sales are not permitted, the Beer, Wine and Malt Beverage sales area shall be closed.

Except as modified by the above provisions, all of the other terms and provisions of Chapter 34 of the Palestine Village Code shall remain in full force and effect.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
